MOBIUS KIDS, OFFERS A SAFE, NURTURING place for young children and their families to learn and grow through hands-on activities, in the arts, cultures, and sciences. With seven interactive exhibits the museum is designed for kids to have a fun hands-on learning experience.

Children can explore Filipino culture in the Bayanihan Village by bargaining at the sari-sari store or shopping at the local market. They can then haul their food and groceries back to the bahay kubo, a child's size replica of a Filipino bamboo house.

Cooper's Corner, named in memory of 13 year-old Cooper Jones who died in a local bicycling accident, promotes the principles of bicycle and traffic safety in a miniature city. Children can practice hand signals while riding a bike, dress up

like a police officer and control traffic, or even visit the local health clinic and diagnose a broken ankle.

In Geotopia kids are able to learn about the effects of erosion caused by water or play in the water table and create channels and paths for boats to race down. Geotopia is also home to Leggy Peggy the Rose hair tarantula, Oswin the African Millipede, stick bugs, and giant hissing cockroaches!

At the Globe Theatre, children have access to costumes and props. Many impromptu, but delightful, plays can be seen on the theatre stage. The Out of Hand Art studio is paradise for the budding artists. Painting, coloring, and fun crafts are always available.

Children up to the age of three can crawl, climb, and romp their way through

the Enchanted Forest. Tots can climb up in the tree house, slide down a soft slide, and play with fun animal puppets.

Each school year, Mobius Kids hosts two traveling exhibits. These exhibits are rented from other museums, like Sciencecenter in Ithaca, NY providing "Cool Moves! The Artistry of Motion!" in 2007. The Mobius in Motion Outreach Program coordinates with these traveling exhibits offering schools, community centers, and civic groups a fun, hands-on learning experience based on the science and math content from the traveling exhibit. Every student who participates in an outreach program receives a free pass to Mobius Kids allowing them to explore all of the exhibits at the museum at a later time.

Throughout the year, Mobius Kids offers fun classes and camps for children of all ages. Children ages two through four can participate in Little Tykes. Wee Explorers is free with admission.

Children ages four through nine learn about science in Science Explorers or Science with Sandy and Magali. There is no better place than Mobius Kids to have a birthday party! A birthday party at Mobius Kids includes exclusive use of the Birthday Lab, our private party room, for an hour and a half. Admission for up to 20 guests is included in the price.
