THE ROCKWOOD CLINIC PEDIATRICS DEPARTMENT

is a group medical practice composed of pediatricians and pediatric nurse practitioners. Each family should select the provider of their choice. A pediatrician is a primary care physician who specializes in the care of infants, children and adolescents. General pediatrics provides for the on-going preventive medical needs for children from birth to age 21. Working as a team, our pediatric providers share their collective experience and knowledge to ensure that our young patients receive the latest diagnostic and treatment options available. They specialize in routine, acute and chronic care including immunizations and sports physicals. With a family-centered approach to keeping children healthy, we answer your questions, provide education, and give reassurance and encouragement to you as a parent. The Rockwood Clinic pediatric physicians are also available to assist the community general practitioner or pediatrician in providing short-term, outpatient care when a second opinion, consultation or referral is needed.

Rockwood Clinic Pediatric services are offered at three locations for your convenience:

Rockwood Clinic knows that not all pediatric concerns or illnesses occur during office hours. After-hours calls are triaged by nurses who offer advice and may direct patients to seek after-hours care at an urgent care center or the emergency room. You may call (509) 459-1590 to speak with



an after-hours consulting nurse.

Rockwood Clinic Family Medicine

Rockwood Clinic's Family Medicine providers work from six different clinical locations conveniently located throughout Spokane County. Family Medicine is a specialty area of medicine that treats a wide range of health conditions from prenatal to end of life care. This includes first-contact care, continuous care, comprehensive care, personal care, and family care using the best available medical knowledge. At the center of this process is the patient-physician relationship with the patient viewed in the context of the family.

A family physician provides primary care. They treat acute and chronic illnesses and provide preventive care and health education for all ages and both sexes. Some of our family physicians also deliver babies and provide obstetric services.

This care is based on knowledge of the patient in the context of the family and the community, emphasizing disease prevention and health promotion. When subspe-

cialty care is indicated, the family physician refers the patient to other specialists or caregivers but remains the coordinator of the patient's health care.

Rockwood Clinic has a growing number of family medicine physicians working with individuals and families from throughout our region. Each of our locations has one or more female providers for women and families seeking a female health care provider.
